- 8. Continual improvement of the OHS Management system to enhance the OHS performance by reduction or elimination of hazardous situations and.
- 9. A pre-emptive and periodic risk assessment and a commitment to the hierarchy of controls aimed at the Prevention of work-related incidents, injuries or accidents and ill health.
- 10. An established consultation and communication process for and of this policy and of its Management System to its employees, sub-contractors and related third parties including interested parties, to provide awareness on the organisation's health and safety obligations and procedures.
- 11. Continuously strive to improve the safe working conditions of its workforce.
- 12. Providing regular and suitable training to its personnel
- 13. The full implementation, review, and monitoring of the Management system to keep this policy and all other processes and procedures updated, current and relevant and appropriate to the company's scope, needs and operations and fully aligned with all legal and other requirements.
